Project background, project outline:	<p>Mongolia has significant coal resources. Inferred coal reserves are roughly 150 billion tons, of which 20 percent is coking coal and 80 percent is lignite or steam coal. The reserves are located in 240 deposits and occurrences in 12 major coal basins, and approximately 25 percent of these deposits have been confirmed by geological survey. There are plenty of sources, having high concentrate of carbon which is applicable for coking, for producing coke.</p> <p>Mongolian government sees the development of its abundant coal resources as a top-priority task.
