Project background, project outline:	On June 9, 2005 the State Great Khural of Mongolia passed the National Program for Renewable Energy. The Government of Mongolia has established aggressive and meaningful targets for wind power development in the intermediate (2010 and 2020) time frame, coupled with objectives for the establishment of a commercially viable project development base. The program is aims to gradually increasing percentage of renewable energy share in the total energy production and reach 3-5 percent share in the total energy supply by the year 2010, and 20-25 percent share by 2020.
