Project basis:	<p>According to the land law, adopted in 1994 and 2002, soum governors are given a right to implement land management activities in accordance with the aimag land management plan of the year.</p> <p>The annual land management plan involves all types of land planning and coordination issues, and since most of soum territory is considered as coordination issues, and since most of soum territory is considered as pastureland, the use and protection of which, is an essential subject. Therefore, land use and planning system needs to be renovated in order to implement long term policy related with pasture and other types of land management.</p> <p>Today, GPS/GIS technology is well known as a main tool for formulation and implementation of land use planning.</p> <p>Most of the soums, except the ones, which have been covered by the donor's assistance, do not have a base digital map to use in practice.</p>
